Scholarship – Applicant Requirements and Particulars**

1. Applicant must be a permanent resident of Indiana.
2. Applicant must be a current college (as of October 2011) first year student – scholarship will be applied to a second year student in a two-year program. Applicant must be enrolled in a program concerning the study of Culinary Arts. College or university must be in Central Indiana.
3. Scholarship will be \$500 and will be sent to a central Indiana culinary school to be applied toward tuition for fall 2012-2013 school year.
4. October 24th, 2011, is deadline for all application materials.
5. 2 professional references must be submitted with application.
6. Essay must be submitted with application.
7. The scholarship recipient will be invited, as a guest, to attend the April 21st, 2012 HSCI Symposium where the recipient will be presented.
