Option 3: The Nashville Zoo. 3777 Nolensville Pike, Nashville. This 200-acre walk-through zoological park is home to rare and beautiful animals and has a beautiful display of plant life. Group rate available if 20 or more sign-up for this option. Regular admission: \$20.00 plus parking.
