Tour of Country Music Hall of Fame 2:00 PM Friday September 9th

COUNTRY MUSIC HALL OF FAME 222 5th Ave S, Nashville, TN 3720 Ticket: \$22 (reservation required)

Discover the stories behind the music as you view over 3,000 stage costumes, original song manuscripts and musical instruments at Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum. Many of the personal items of music legends are on display including Elvis' solid gold Cadillac. Tour includes a visit to the historic RCA Studio B and the Music Row walking tour. Allow at least two hours for exhibits and the tour.

The downtown building was designed by Nashville's Tuck-Hinton Architectural Firm with Seab Tuck as the project architect. When viewed from the air, the building forms a massive bass clef. The point on the sweeping arch of the building suggests the tailfin of a 1959 Cadillac sedan. The building's front windows resemble piano keys. The tower on top of the Rotunda that extends down the Hall of Fame is a replica of the distinctive diamondshaped WSM radio tower, which was originally built in 1932 just south of Nashville and is still in operation.

THE NASHVILLE ZOO 3777 Nolensville Pike, Nashville, TN 37211 Ticket: \$16-25 + parking



This 200-acre walk-through zoological park is home to the rare and beautiful. You'll encounter cougars, black bears, Bengal tigers, zebras, cheetahs and playful river otters. The animals come from many parts of the world. There are nearly 3,000 animals representing more than 350 different species at Nashville Zoo. The Croft Center, named for the sisters who left the estate to Grassmere, houses the Unseen New World exhibit and a variety of reptiles. There is also a working farm exhibit and a petting zoo. BELLE MEADE PLANTATION

5025 Harding Pike Nashville TN 37205 Ticket: \$32 individual/ \$22 each group of 15



A <u>historic mansion</u> that is now operated as an attraction, museum, winery, and onsite restaurant together with outbuildings on its 30 acres of property. In the late 19th century, the plantation encompassed roughly 5,400 acres with over a hundred slaves.

Preserved original outbuildings, including the original Harding Cabin where Belle Meade began, a dairy, a gardener's house, a carriage and stable house built in 1892, one of the largest smokehouses in Tennessee, and a mausoleum may also be seen. Since the 1990s, the executive leadership of the site began an effort to reconcile the past and to tell the stories of African Americans who were brought to and born at Belle Meade and worked there before and after emancipation. The Mansion Tour tells the century-long history of Belle Meade through the stories and experiences of the Harding and Jackson families, as well as the enslaved women, men, and children who were held in bondage here. The Journey to Jubilee Tour invites discussion and explores the stories of the enslaved African-Americans who were brought to, and born at Belle Meade from 1807 through the years following Emancipation.

The Frist Art Museum housed in the city's historic U.S. Post Office building, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

THE HERMITAGE 4580 Rachel's Lane, Nashville, TN 37076

A striking glimpse into America's antebellum eon, the Hermitage tells tales of the life of the country's seventh president, Andrew Jackson.

CENTENNIAL PARK & THE PARTHENON 2600 West End Ave, Nashville, TN37203

It is fitting that the "Athens of the South" is home to the world's only full-size replica of the ancient Parthenon. Featured is Athena Parthenos, the tallest indoor sculpture of the western world recreated by Alan LeQuire.
